Welcome to 'Bishop's Castle Thrive'

Harnessing the talents and resources of our local community. Promoting an inclusive network that supports and enhances the lives of vulnerable people as well as other groups by promoting health, well-being, skills and knowledge.

We are aiming to create a Hub to help our community to thrive.

The Hub could be situated in an accessible location, offering a joined-up service to all ages in our community:

- acts as a 'central Hub', where people can drop in to find out about services either directly provided or virtually coordinated from multiple locations.
- these services, we hope, will form complimentary 'Micro-hubs' of different activities and topics.

The Central Hub gives opportunity for a space for anyone to **walk in, talk to us and connect into their community.**

It could guide people to existing functions such as the Food Bank, IT Centre, and library, and to a range of new services planned to answer community needs.

Services might include youth provision, social prescribing, debt and benefits advice, energy advice, health promotion, job preparation, a variety of safe spaces, and access to advocacy services.

We hope to focus on the inclusion of vulnerable groups by using specific job roles that address different type of community need.

This brochure is the first step in how we best approach you all - it shows our vision.

The Thrive Community Hub:

A community health and social care hub made by the community for the community; meeting community needs for optimum potential.

- With workshop/ meeting room and safe space style facilities;
- People from all ages and backgrounds should feel connected, respected and believed in;
- All can gain access to the right help and advice, with the possibility of being referred to services in our area;
 - Making workshops available for fun or as up-skill training;
- The main ethos is to help vulnerable groups but also promote health and well-being for **ALL** groups in our area.

Forming Micro-hubs:

These are diverse established parts/groups of our community that can offer health promotion and life experience.

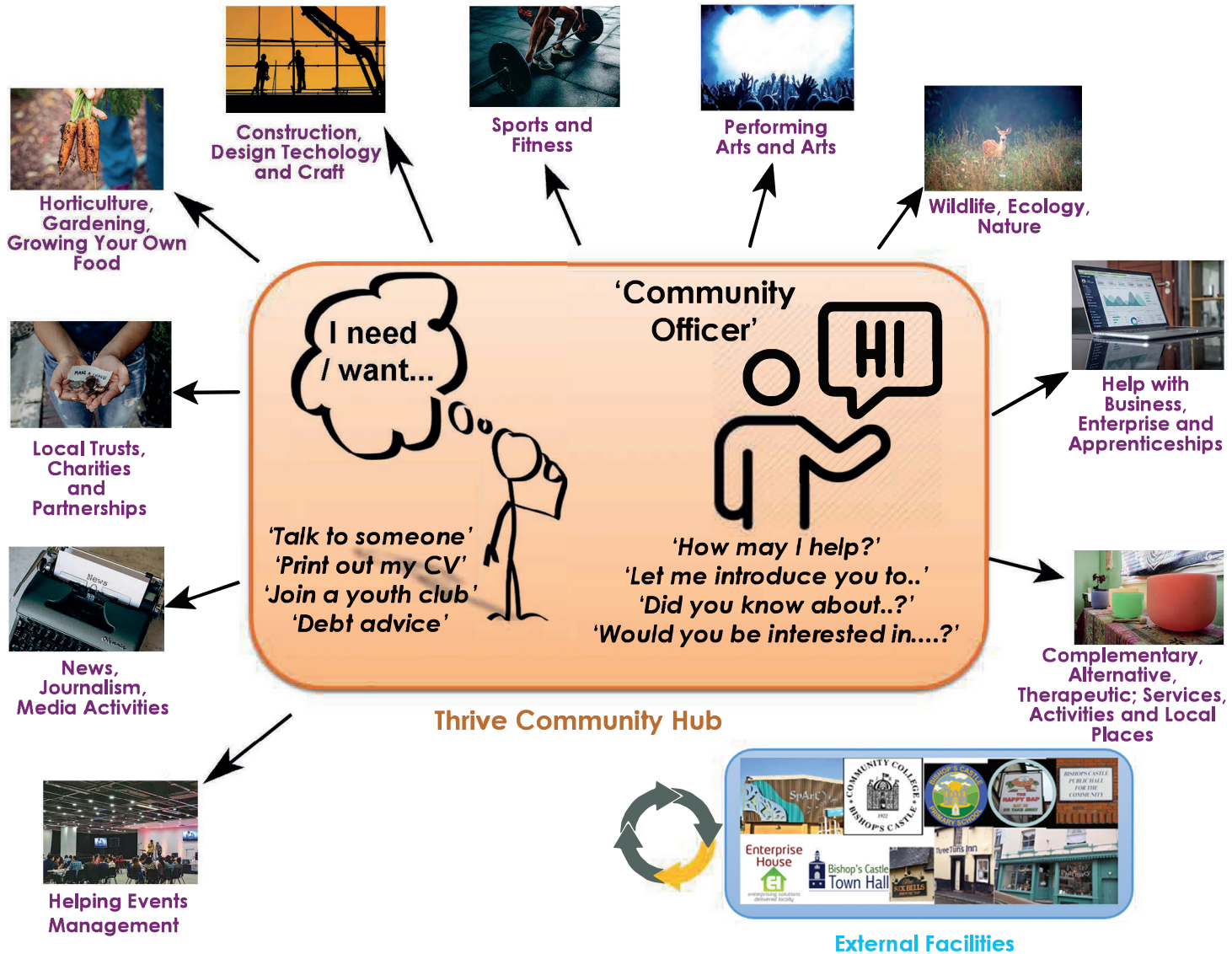
- The Central Hub will connect the Micro-hubs to local people so they can be directed to the right type of intervention - very interactive and vocational;
 - Fun activities, social clubs and events;
- Inviting locals to gain entrepreneurial skills by showing them different work environments within the Micro-hubs, getting them involved with community affairs and allowing them to shape their own aims through this experience;
 - This joined up approach could allow for job vacancies to be made known and recommended more quickly to local people.
